Experience Holy Week in a New and Meaningful Way!
Multi-Sensory Passion Meditation Stations

Following all Holy Week services, your family is invited to the Family Life Center to visit the Multi-Sensory Meditation Stations. These stations are designed for you to experience the Passion story in a variety of sensory ways. Your senses and understanding of the meaning of Passion events will be heightened as you visit as many of the stations as you like. The Stations and locations include:

IN THE FAMILY LIFE CENTER:

- ***What did Jesus hear?** Listen to some of the sound Jesus might have heard during the last week of his life.
- ***Pottery cross.** Using shards of pottery, write what you want to give up to God and glue the pottery shard to a large cross.
- ***Envisioning Christ.** View a DVD with a number of artistic images of Christ from throughout the centuries. Art supplies are provided if you would like to respond by creating your own image.
- ***Read and Write.** Read poetry, short stories, devotionals, and other materials related to the Passion. If you like, you may do some creative writing of your own.
- ***What did Jesus feel?** Experience, by touch, some of the objects Jesus encountered during the last hours of

his life.

***Footwashing.** Have your feet washed by one with a servant's heart. You may take the opportunity to wash someone else's feet if you like.

IN THE GARDEN AREA NEXT TO THE SANCTUARY:

***Garden.** The garden area is open for prayer and meditation, weather permitting.

The meditation stations will be available following each service on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. They will also be open all morning on Easter Sunday.

May these services and experiences help you connect with the story of God's love in new and meaningful ways this Holy Week.
